


Use the breadcrumbs at the top of the *Grain Offers* page to navigate back to the *Grain* page.


Signing into Barchart

To sign in to Barchart for the first time through Grower360, the grower must select the **Sign in to Barchart to view all current offers** link. The following verification process must be completed by the grower:

1. Enter an email at the Barchart login window then select **Next**.

Note: This should be the grower's email.







2. A verification code will be sent to the email provided. Obtain this code and enter it into the verification field then select **Submit**.


3. Enter the *First Name*, *Last Name*, and *Mobile Phone*, then select **Save**.

5. Choose **Authorize** on the *Authorize Grower360* window.





Accepting allows growers to create Grain Offers through Grower360.


Creating a New Offer

1. Select **Create New Offer**.
2. The **Pencil** icon can be selected at the top right to choose the desired Commodity.

3. Select the Location from the *Location* drop-down. Choose the desired Futures Month from the grid.

4. From the *Select Offer Type* drop-down, choose the type of Grain Offer to be created.

Note: These are set up within Barchart and can be turned on and off as desired.

5. Enter additional offer details including # of Bushels, Price, and Date (which must be greater than or equal to the current date).

6. Optionally enter any notes in the Notes field.

7. Once finished, select **Submit Offer** to save the Grain Offer.

Once a new offer is entered and saved, it displays in the *Grain Offers* grid with a *Status* of *Pending*. Additionally, an email is sent to the grower outlining the Grain Offer details.

Grain Offers submitted by growers can be viewed, accepted, or declined by logging into the Barchart Match Offer System. If accepted, the *Status* of the Grain Offer in Grower360 changes to *Accepted* and an email notification is sent to the grower.



If a Grain Offer is still in a *Status* of *Pending*, the offer can be cancelled by selecting the **Ellipsis** to the right of the offer and choosing **Cancel Offer**. This will remove the offer from the *Grain Offers* grid and the *Status* of the offer on the Barchart Match Offer System will update to *Cancelled*.
